







Curriculum Overview

<p>In maths this term, students will be add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole. Pupils will add and subtract fractions and mixed numbers and will solve problems that involve all of the above. Pupils will understand improper fractions and will be able to convert mixed numbers to improper fractions.</p>		<p>This term, pupils will learn all about earthquakes and volcanoes. They will be able to describe what causes an earthquake; locate areas in the world that are more susceptible to earthquakes and explain why that is. Pupils will be able to identify, describe and explain the causes of volcanoes; explain why volcanoes often occur at the same location as earthquakes</p>

They will learn to sing in tune and perform their actions in time.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Sound</p> <p>Children will identify and describe different sounds. They will learn that sounds are produced by vibrations and that these vibrations travel from the source of the sound through a variety of materials to the ear.. Working Scientifically, children will have the opportunity to investigate how sound travels through solids, liquids and gases.</p>
