Re: Online Home Learning Provision During COVID 19 School Building Closure

Dear Parents/Carers of **Years 3 & 4**

We the years three and four team, hope that you have had a restful break and are rearing to go. We are very excited about welcoming our students back to the start of the Spring Term 2021.

I am sure that with the announcement of school closures again, it is raising some concerns for you and possibly questions. I hope that this letter will allay any concerns you might have but in the event that your questions are not answered, please do not hesitate to contact the Lower Key Stage 2 team at your earliest convenience.

With the announcement that school buildings are being closed due to the high risks of COVID 19 spreading, we will continue with our online learning provision until further updates are provided. The online home provision will begin on Wednesday 6th January, throughout the first Spring half term; further updates as to when pupils are expected to return back to school will be provided before the end of the next half term break (Friday 12th February)

As far as is possible the LKS2 team want to make the transition to learning in this way as smooth as possible for our students. The expectations of the teachers are still very high, and we are looking to offer the same standard of teaching online as we would in face to face teaching in the classroom.

For this to continue we would ask that your child/ren are ready to join the classroom on Microsoft teams at 9:00am – each child has already been given their log in details. If there is a problem, please call the school office. Tel: 0208 961 5336.

The morning session will be live teaching of the core subjects, Math, English, Reading, this live teaching will end at 12:00pm. The afternoon sessions will consist of foundation subjects which will be uploaded onto the Seesaw platform for students to work through at the own pace. However, work must be uploaded for the teacher to mark by 3:00pm.

If your child does not have access to the internet from home, please contact their class teacher via Class Dojo as soon as possible so that we can arrange for a home learning pack to be printed and left the school office for you to collect.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we try to ensure that your child's education continues as smoothly as possible.
