Literacy



As Readers, we will be:

- Developing knowledge of letter sounds
- Hearing and saying sounds in words, for example the sounds in string are: s-t-r-i-ng
- Segmenting sounds in words and blending, for example s-t-a-m-p...stamp.
- Reading tricky words and high frequency words fluently
- Talking about the stories we have read

As Writers, we will be:

- Practising writing simple sentences, - e.g. It is a dog.
- Write simple sentences using describing words, e.g. It is a green car.
- Write tricky words learnt during phonics.
