Measures - Shape

This term, Year 5 will become accurate in drawing lines with a ruler to the nearest millimetre and

measuring with a protractor. They will use conventional markings for parallel lines and right angles. The children will use the term diagonal and make conjectures about the angles formed between sides, and between diagonals and parallel sides, and other properties of quadrilaterals, for example using dynamic geometry ICT tools.




In this Benin unit children will look in depth at where the ancient
