











Curriculum Overview

MATHS		History		
<p>Place value and the four operations</p>  <p>In maths this term, students will be consolidating their knowledge of multiplication and division. Students will be able to use dienes, counters, place value charts and the column method in order to grasp the concepts of place value and place holders.</p>		<p>This term, pupils will learn all about the Roman's. Children will develop an understanding of what happened when the Roman's came to Britain. They will learn about Roman invasions, develop their chronology skills by looking at timelines, and the impact the Romans had on Britain.</p>

<p>In English this term, children will be exploring 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. They will be looking at writing features to be able to plan and write their own narratives. They will also be writing diary entries in the role of different characters using different types of sentences. Children will also be able to recognise the difference between informal and formal letters and understand the different features that are used.</p> 		<p>Respectful relationships</p>  <p>This term in PSHE, children will be exploring the themes of what a good relationship is. They will be discussing what a healthy or unhealthy relationship is. They will be looking at kind words and how to show good manners.</p>	<p>Sculpture</p>  <p>In Art this term, children will explore musical instruments and how to create them out of different materials. They will create maracas in their first lesson made of recycled plastic bottles, items found around the classroom and rice.</p>	<p>Gymnastics</p>  <p>This term, Year 4 will be learning different concepts of gymnastics. They will be looking at travelling, shape, balance, rolling, jumping and sequence building in gymnastics.</p>
