Dear Parents,

As we approach Easter, I wanted to write to celebrate the successes of the school and update you on some of the events that are taking place over the next few months.

Parent engagement has continued to improve with increased numbers of parents attending workshops and parent forums. Thank you so much for supporting us and please continue to come to these events so we can work together to make the school better for the children. As you know we have relaunched Marvellous Mondays this half term, so every Monday you are able to come on site and look at your children's books and talk to your children's teachers. This runs every Monday from 3:15 to 3:45 in your child's classrooms – please do come and join us.

We have also introduced STEAM. STEAM is a science-based program that supports the development of science, technology, engineering, arts and maths. Over the course of the next term all year groups will take part in STEAM activities to promote the wider curriculum, ambition and develop possible career opportunities.

Eco-warriors have visited Wembley stadium to learn about sustainability and how we can further improve our school community through various strategies. This was a very exciting day and eco-warriors will now be leading projects around the school to support this program.

Student leadership meetings have taken place and all student leaders now have a focus for this half term. This includes;

- School council – coming up with ideas on how to improve our library
- Eco Warriors – encouraging the children and staff to recycle and coming up with ideas to create an eco-friendly school
- Behaviour mentors – KS2 behaviour mentors interacting with the KS1 children and modelling social skills
- Prefects – working alongside the ambassadors to model impeccable behaviour and showing a positive attitude towards learning
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As we approach Easter, we will be assessing all children and having pupil progress reviews to ensure the support in place for your children is appropriate and accelerate their progress. The first week back after half term will be parent conference day. More information will follow on this, but we look forward to seeing you in school to discuss your children's progress.
