MATHEMATICS



Area of Focus – Measurement of length, Mass and volume: Writing length in metres and centimetres, reading weighing scales, measuring Volume in millilitres and litres, word problems involving all year 3 curriculum expectations.

History

Area of focus – Stone age to Iron Age.
Children will learn about how the Stone Age to Bronze Age period impacted on life in Britain.

Area of focus – Respectful relationships

We will understand how to show respect in different settings, define courtesy and manners and recognise healthy and unhealthy relationships.

Reading

Our first core text this term is The Twits. We are also reading Matilda for Guided Reading. The focus is comprehension and answering questions based on the text.

- Postcard and poetry

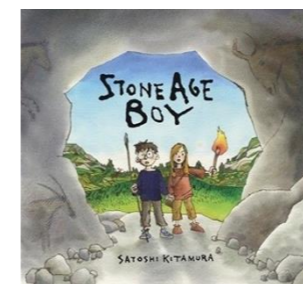
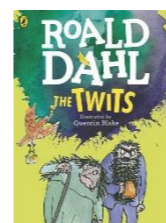
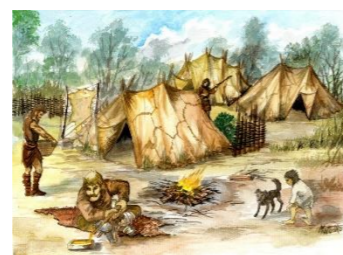

Geography



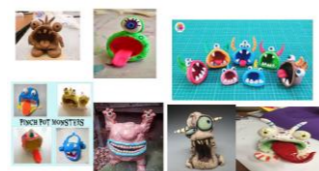
Area of Focus – Rivers and seas

Areas of focus – (History: Stone Age)

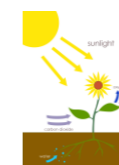
