Reading Books

Children need to be reading every night at home and are reminded to bring their books to change every week or when they have completed their reading books.

Please listen to your child reading out loud and ask questions about what they have read to support the development of their comprehension skills.

Many reading books have not been returned to school since the period of remote learning. Please ensure all reading books are returned to the class by the 23rd April. If a reading book is lost or damaged, £5.00 will need to be paid to the school to replace it.

Homework will continue to be issued every Friday. It should be completed to a high standard and submitted by the following Wednesday at the latest.
